
## **How to Edit Page Content**


**Tip!** Stick to editing text only — avoid deleting or moving widgets, as this can affect the layout.



## 6 **Changing an IMAGE** (cont.)

- Within the "Insert Media" popup:
   **Upload** a new image OR pick one already uploaded to the **Media Library**.
   Hit **Select** in the bottom right to insert the new image.







## **Something looks wrong?**

- Use Ctrl + Z (Windows) or Cmd + Z (Mac) while still in the editor to quickly undo.
- If undo-ing doesn't work, **close out** of the tab without Publishing.
